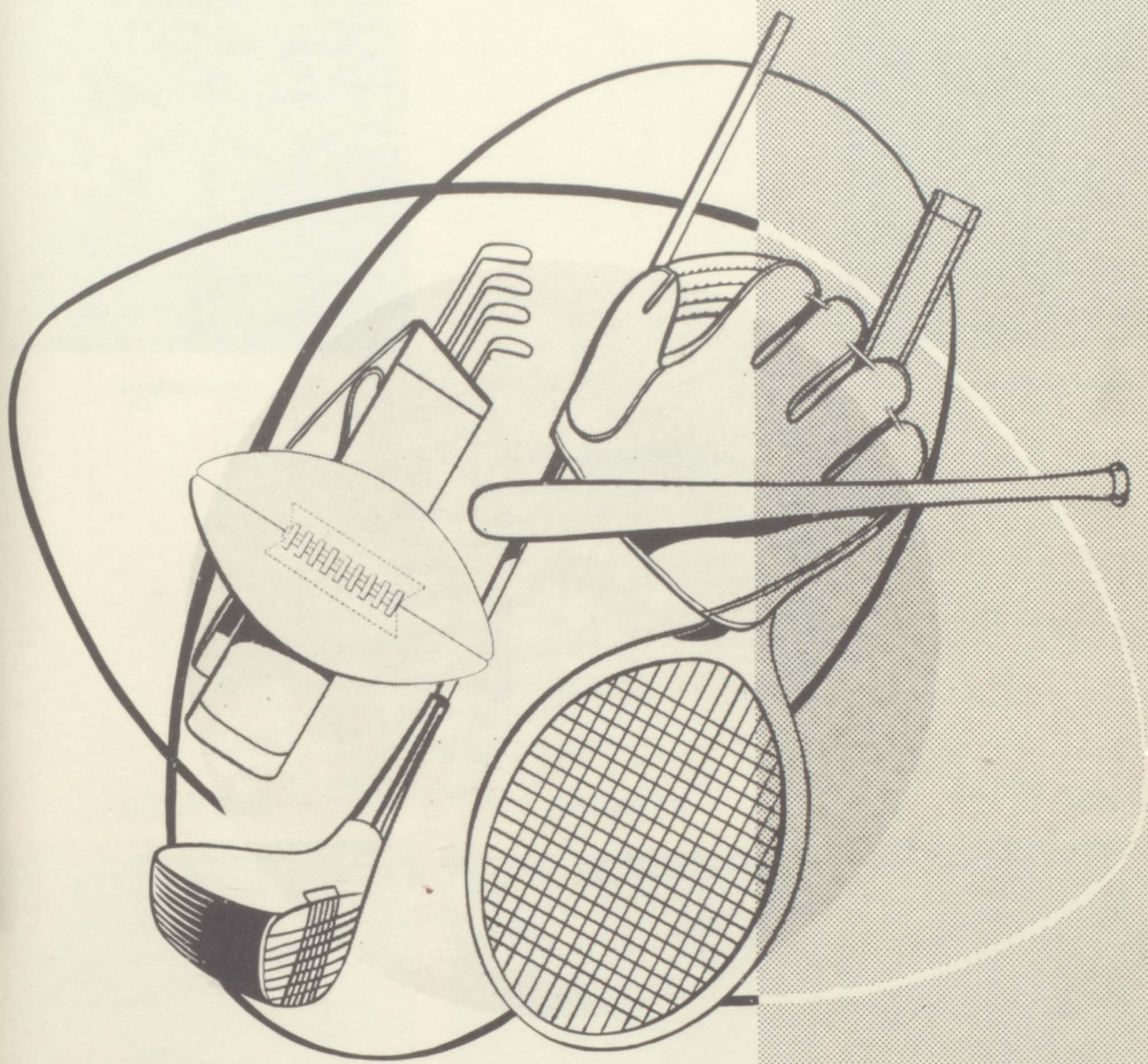
CHARLENE BALDWIN
