Karen Van Tine--Karen is now touring the world with Ringling Bros. Barnum and Bailey Circus as the World's Smallest Woman.

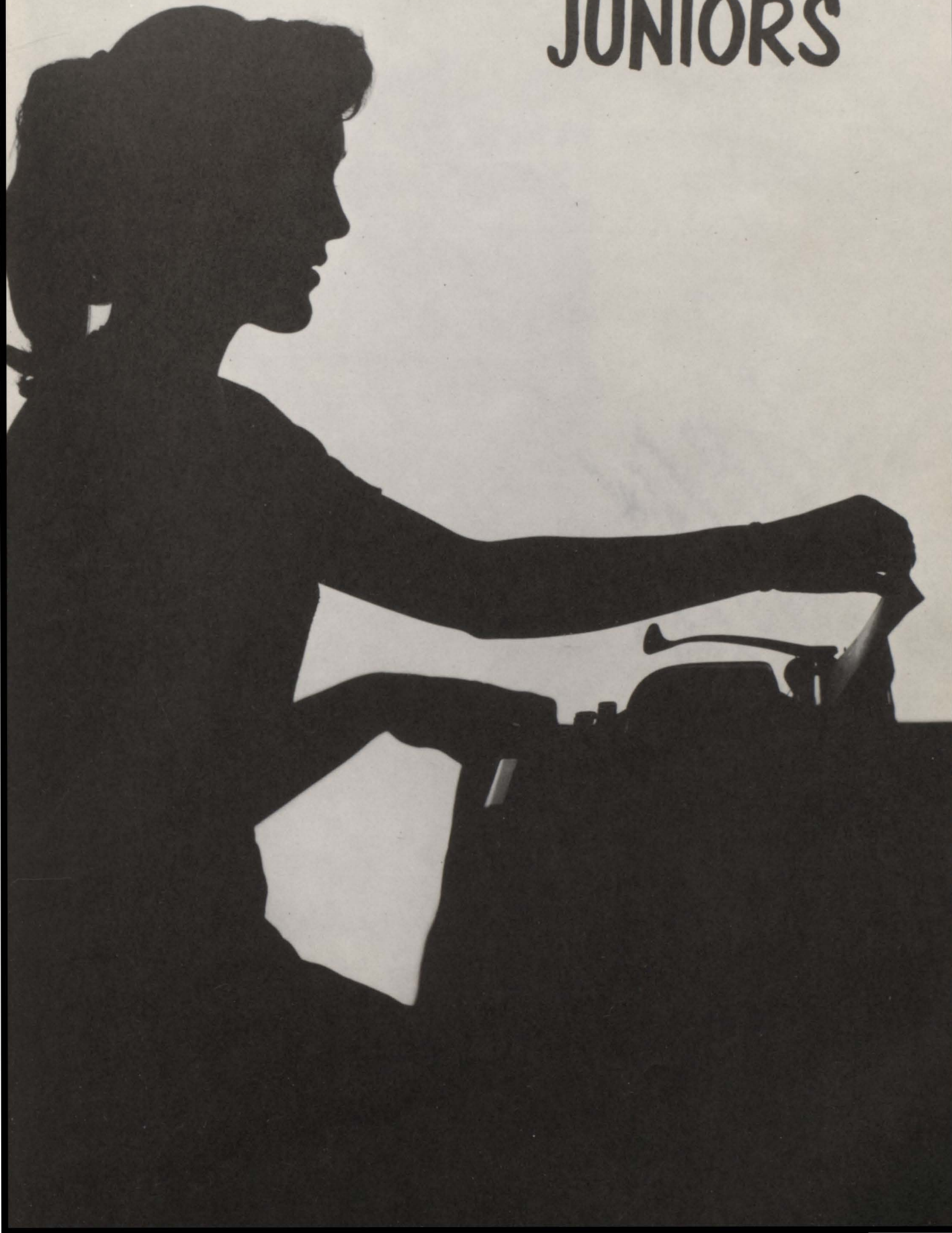
