## CLASS HISTORY

In 1954, we entered Media High School as Freshmen, with a class of sixteen. As class officers, we chose: Bonnie Bultemeier, Pres; Ray Carlson, Vice-Pres; Norma Berg, Secy; Linda Kemp, Treas; Sue Perrine, Reporter. Our class advisor was Mrs. Doris Palmer. On November 16 we had a Sadie Hawkins' Party for the whole school. Bob Burghorn and Sue Perrine left during the year.

On August 29, 1955, fourteen sophomores were ready to begin their second year at Media High. We elected the following officers: Linda Reynolds, Pres; Bonnie Bultemeier, Vice-Pres; Norma Berg, Sec; Jean Anders, Treas; Ray Rosenbalm, Reporter. We chose Miss Jurgensen and Mr. Shelton as our advisors. Linda Reynolds and Gerry Lenz were our Homecoming representatives. Our candidates for the Junior Carnival were Norma Berg and Sam Waterman. We were happy when Norma was chosen queen. John Boone, Doralee Newland, and Irvin Humes moved away the first of the year.

Our Junior year really began when we received our class rings. Having ordered them in the spring of our Sophomore year, they arrived shortly after the opening of school. Our class officers for this year were; Norma Berg, Pres; Ray Carlson, Vice-Pres; Linda Reynolds, Secy; Linda Kemp, Treas; Joyce Reid, Reporter. Student Council representatives were Jean Anders and Ray Carlson. Miss Bodeen and Mr. Bowen served as our class advisors. This year Joyce Reid and Linda Reynolds were chosen as varsity cheerleaders. Our class skit, "The Viper," won second place at the Homecoming Pep Rally. Ray Carlson and Linda Kemp were our candidates for the Homecoming Dance. Linda was crowned queen. For our Junior Carnival, we chose Jean Anders and Gerry Lenz as candidates for queen and king. On March 22, 1957, the class presented a humorous play, "Grandad Steps Out." It was directed by our English teacher, Miss Bodeen. We sponsored the Junior-Senior Banquet, which was held at the Hotel Burlington, May 18. Our theme was "STARDUST." We welcomed Gwen Inghram and Bob Parrack back into the class.

THIS IS IT: Twelve seniors were ready for our last year at M. H. S. Pres, Jean Anders; Vice-Pres, Martin Jacobs; Secy, Norma Berg; Treas, Linda Reynolds; Reporter, Ray Carlson. Joyce Reid and Gerry Lenz were our Student Council Representatives, with Ray Carlson as President of the organization. We chose Mrs. Edythe Johnson and Mr . Walker to be our advisors. Our first big event was our Homecoming with Kirkwood on September 27, 1957. Our king and queen candidates for the dance were Sam Waterman and Gwen Inghram. We were all very happy when they were crowned King and Queen. We presented our class play, "The House Nobody Lived In," on November 8. Our senior pictures arrived in time for us to give them as Christmas gifts. January 17, 1958, ended our first semester. These were the last semester tests we were to take at Media High School. To earn money for our class trip we picked up corn, sponsored eat stands at our home football and basketball games, collected scrap iron, and had a clean-up day. May was full of great expectations. The Juniors honored our class with a Junior-Senior Banquet on May 3. On May 18 was Baccalaureate and on May 20 we received our diplomas. . We left Media for our trip East on May 22.
