Basketball, football, English and chorus domecoming, banquet all this before us.



Sixteen Freshmen entered Media High School when it opened Aug. 29, 1955. The following officers and advisors were elected; Pres.-Sharon Milligan: V. Pres.-Bonnie Swanson; Sec.--Patty Lee; Treas.-Russell Coburn; Reporter--Darvis Overstreet; Advisors---Mrs. Mayhew and Mr. Sibbing.

On August 30, thirteen Sophomores entered Media for their second term. We elected the following officers to lead our class onward; Pres.--Russell Coburn; V. Pres;--Neal Brokaw; Sec.--Bonnie Swanson; Treas.--Bill McCollum; Reporter--J.D. Bricker. Curtis Flatt and Gary Harden were chosen to represent us at Student Council. Mrs. Dietz and Mr. Shelton were selected as our advisors.

During the first semester we lost Eddy Lenz and gained and lost Terry Wilson.

Neal Brokaw; Reporter--Russell Coburn; Student Council Bill McCollum and Gary Harden. Mrs. Duncan and Mr. Bowen were our class sponsors. On April 25, the class presented a three-act comedy play "Rest Assured." Mrs. Johnson, our English teacher, directed the play.
