Our Homecoming candidates were Gloria Carnes and Mike Day.

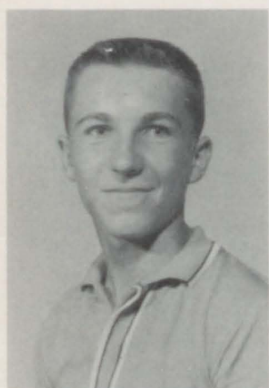
Our Carnival candidates were Linda Barber and Russell White. We were very pleased when Linda was chosen Carnival Queen.

On August 26, 1961, the Freshman Class had an enrollment of 26 members. In November we lost Sandra Stoneking but gained Alan Bowling.

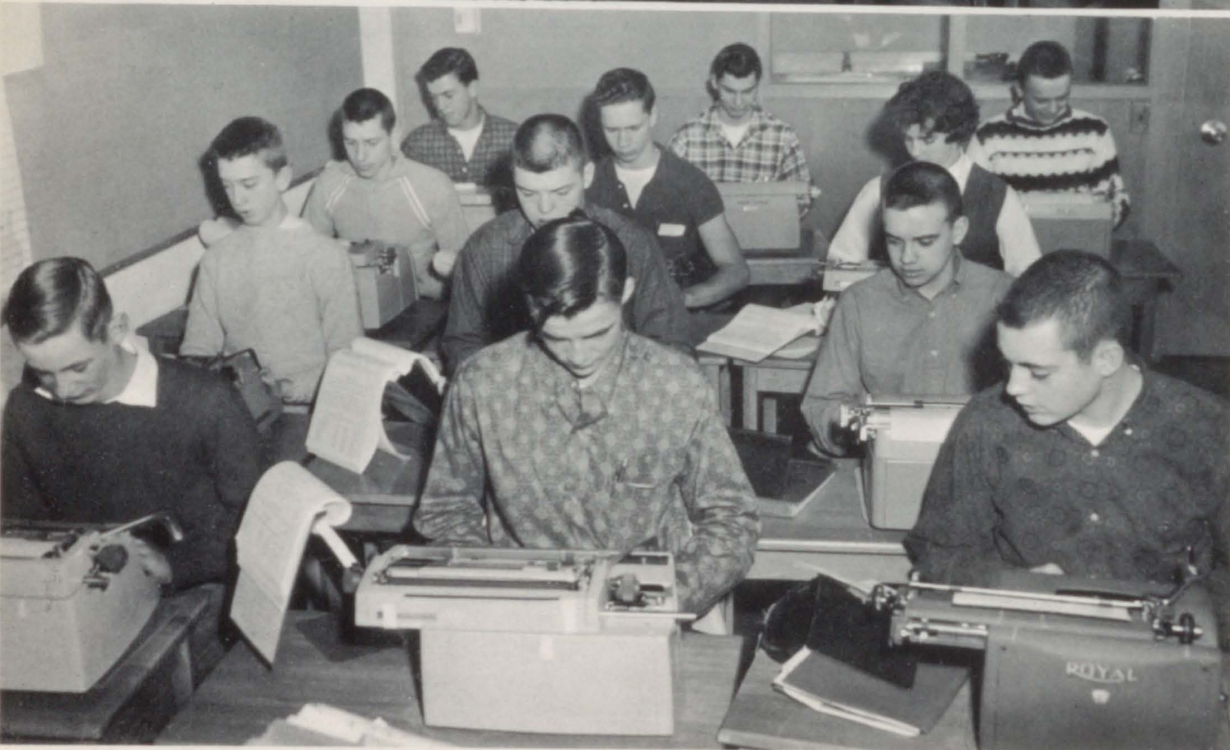
