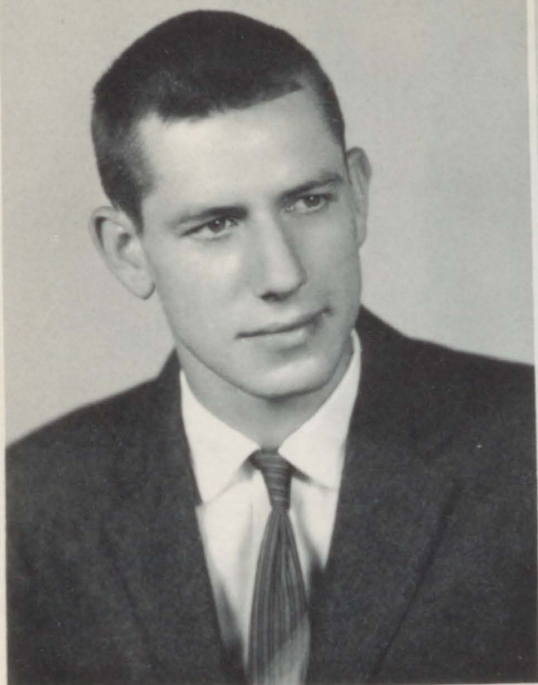
C L A S S H I S T O R Y
