





In 1966, Mr. Walker discontinued his classroom duties and stepped into the position of Superintendent of Media-Wever School District #103.



The 1966-67 football season was a successful one for the Media-Wever football team. Six victories against one loss enabled the squad to establish the best winning record since 11-man football was instituted at Media. The six wins gave the Bulldogs title to an undisputed second place finish in the Bi-County Conference. This is the best gridiron record at Media since 1952.


