We started our Sophomore year with twenty members. Carol Bjork, a transfer student from Union High School, joined our class at the beginning of the year.

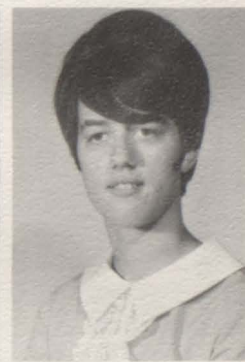
