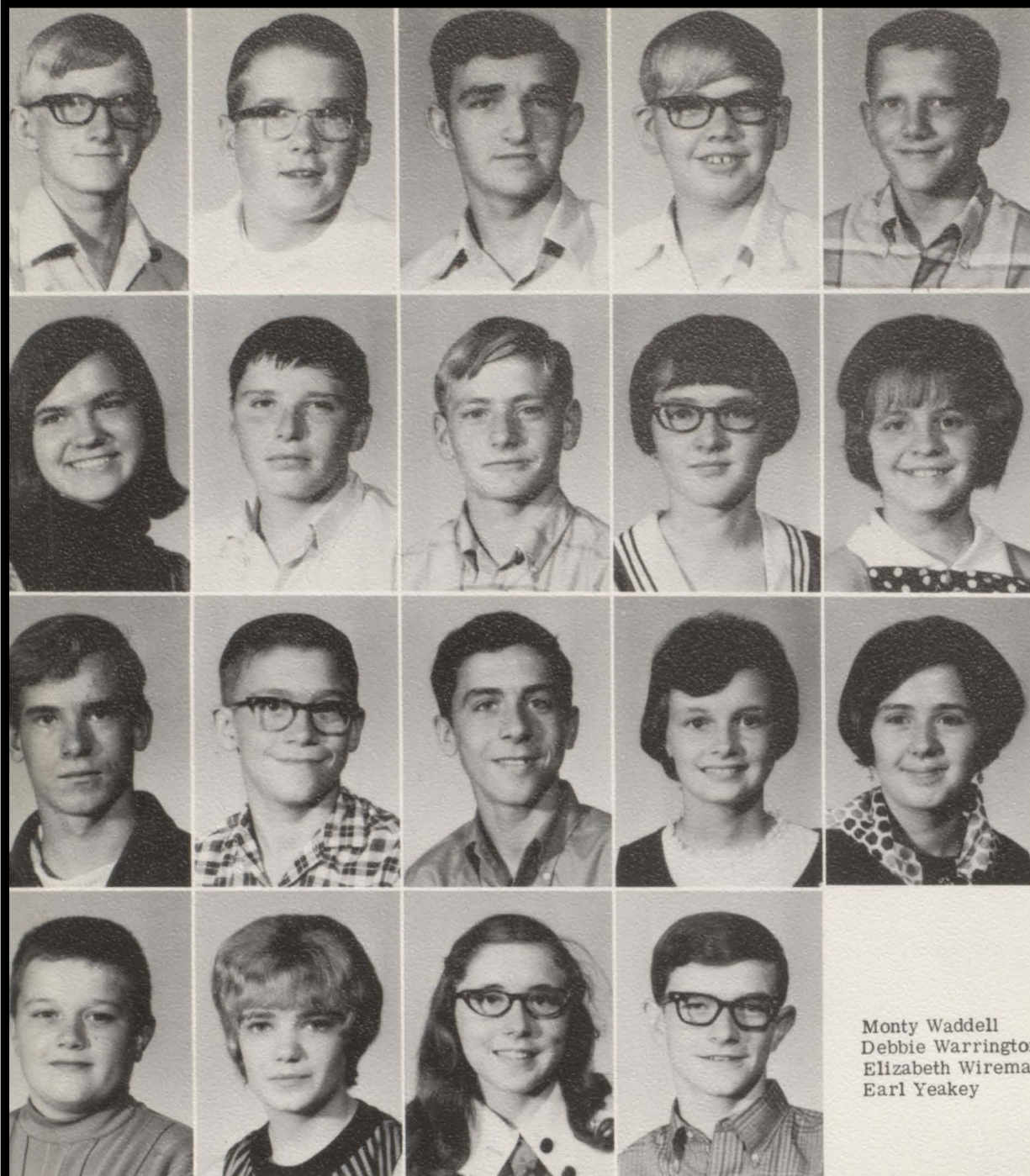
Sophomores
