The library at Southern High School is now better equipped to meet the needs of students than at any time in the past. A full-time librarian now supervises the library. In addition, books, periodicals, and equipment have been secured which provide students with more opportunity for meaningful research.

The library provides students with a pamphlet file, audio-visual materials and equipment, typewriters, and study carrels. Study carrels are similar to desks and are divided by a partition. They are equiped to accommodate audio-visual equipment such as a filmstrip projector or record player (with earphones). Students using study carrels are not easily distracted because of the partitions.

Pupils at Southern find the library a quiet area in which to study, to read, or to do research. Those who qualify for the study commons are free to use the library at any time. Other students must obtain a pass from their classroom teacher or from the librarian prior to signing out of study hall for the library.

The library is presently being developed into a learning resource center. A learning resource center is an improvement over the traditional library as students have access to audio-visual materials and equipment which aid in learning.

The person responsible for the development and for the eventual success of a learning resource center must be extremely versatitle. This individual, in addition to being responsible for all printed materials in the library, must also supervise the use of all audiovisual equipment (film projectors, filmstrip projectors, record players, tape recorders, movie projectors, casset players, filmstrips, slides, movies, etc.).

Another responsibility of the person in charge of a learning resource center is to coordinate the film requests for the unit. Members of the unit faculty turn in their requests for films a week in advance. The learning resource center specialist arranges all requests on a single form which is taken to the Warren-Henderson County Film Cooperative in Monmouth. Educational films are then secured for use in the classrooms the following week.

Student Assistants play a vital role in the successful operation of the high school learning center. These volunteers occupy the check-out desk next to the entrance of the library. They help other students check materials in and out of the library, assist students and faculty members in locating materials, and answer general questions concerning the library.

Future plans include the addition of books, materials, and equipment to provide students, faculty, and members of the community with an attractive, well-equipped, contemporary resource learning center.
