Mr. Blasi gave an award to the 1972-73 Student Council officers.

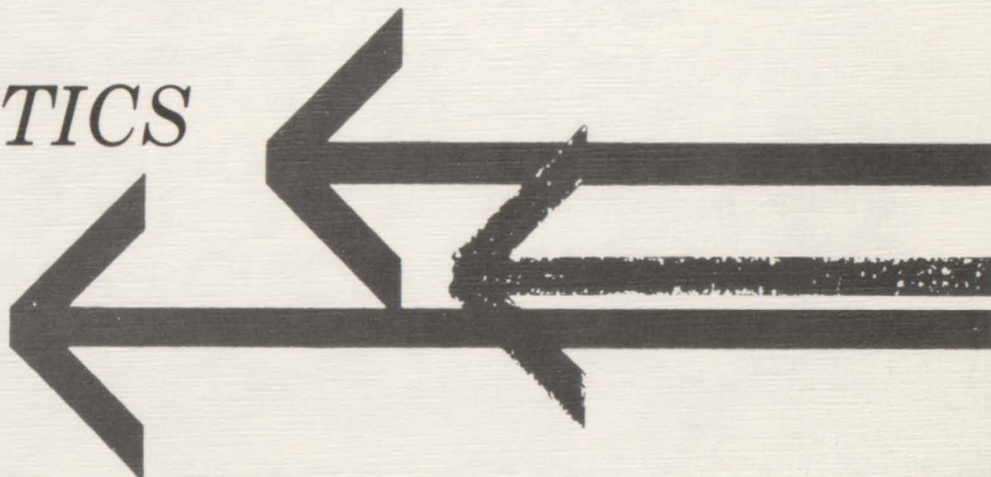
