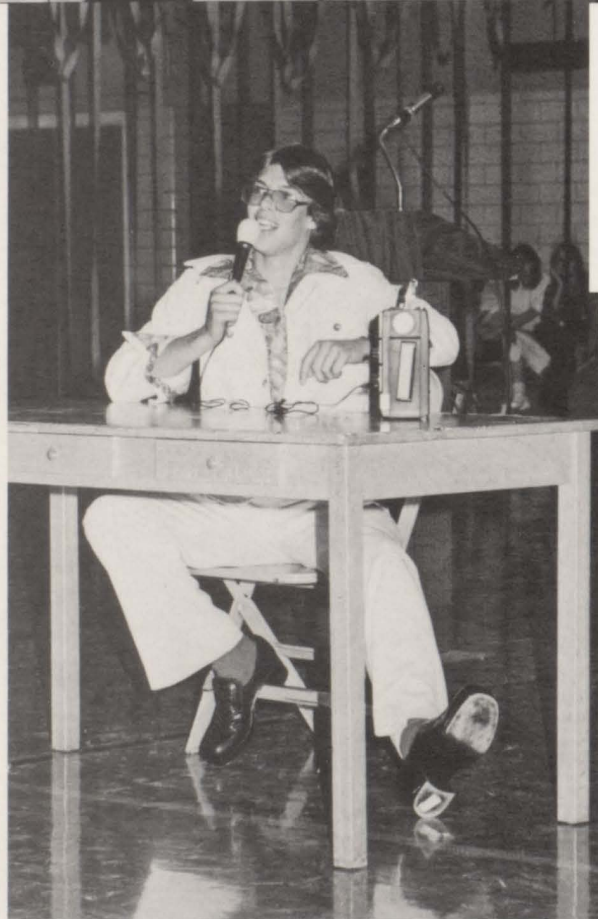




HOMECOMING 1977

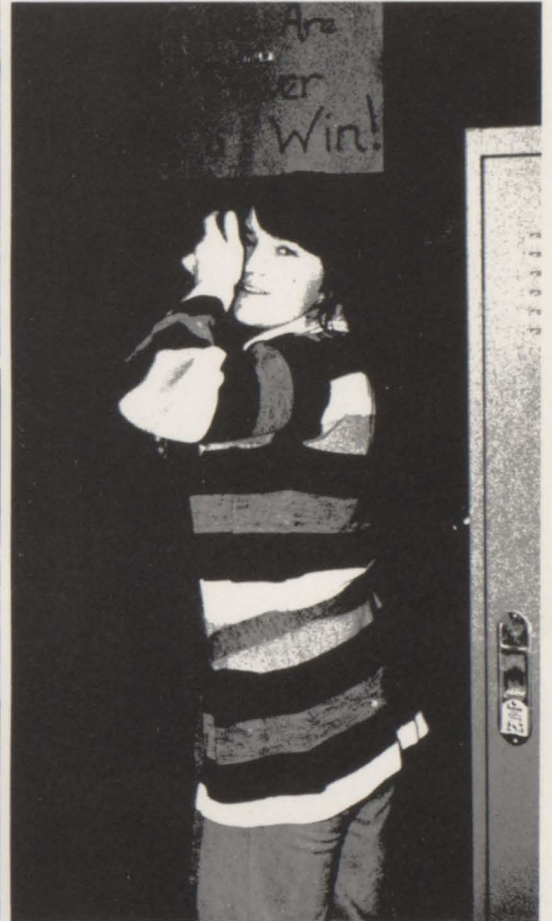

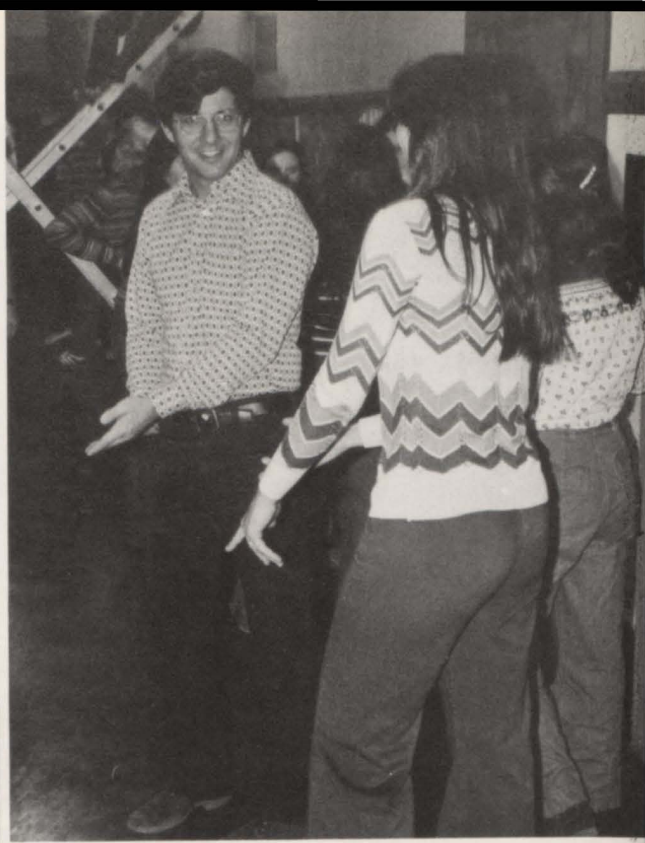

After Prom a bowling party was held at Bowl Inn, which was attended by a number of students, faculty, and board members.



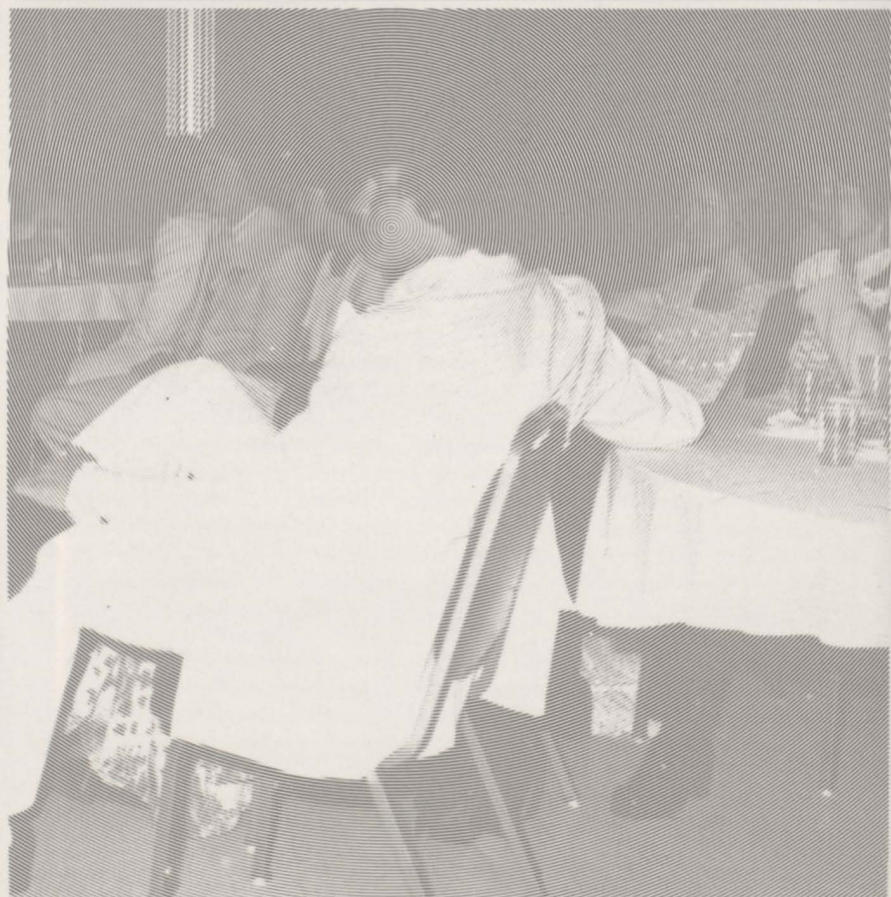
