Ronald will be remembered here at S.H.S.



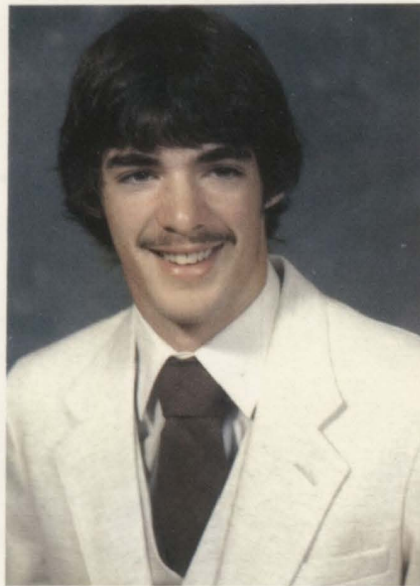
