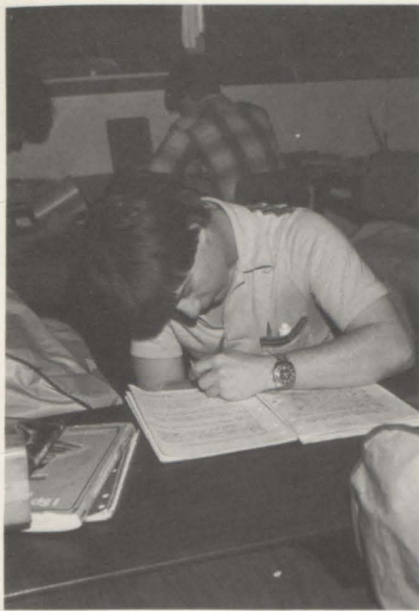
Amy Dowell has settled down. Mike finally gave in and they had a June wedding. The couple now resides in Roseville where Amy teaches the Roseville re-re's.

This puts an end to tonight's reunion. We'd like to wish you and yours many more — **"HAPPY TRAILS!"**



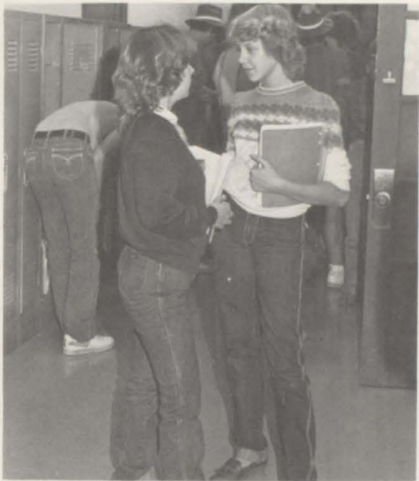
