# Naochan Visits S.H.S.

I'm glad to be in the best class, the CLASS of '87. Hi, I'm Naochan Watanabe, and I came here from Tokyo, Japan, in July of 1986. Though at first I really did not know the way to talk correctly, the kids here were friendly and nice. I picked up almost all of my language from them. Sometimes, though, I used it wrong in the classroom.

I really enjoy the nature and the scenery around Stronghurst. Believe it or not, I had never seen the sunrise come up over the horizon before, nor a sunset. I am not a romantic person at all, but when I went horseback riding with a friend she said that she was going to show me something beautiful. We climbed a hill, and I thought she was going to show me her treasure. Then I saw a beautiful, red sun going down into the horizon. I was impressed indeed.

I really did not have culture shock when I came here, but I still had little problems. At my Japanese school we had ten-minute breaks between classes, and here it is only three!!! The first week I was late to every single class. I thought, "Gee! How do the other kids move so fast?" I always had to go to the bathroom or talk to some teacher about a question or do some homework for my next class. But finally I learned. If I wanted to go to the bathroom, I had to hold it until after school or lunch hour. And if I wanted to blow my nose, I learned to use Kleenex in the classroom. (In Japan we always go to the bathroom and flush the toilet and blow our nose so no one will hear it). These are not big differences; my biggest problem was food. I didn't miss Japanese food; I can eat anything except gummy worms. I think they are really something different. I'm glad you don't have gummy mice with long tails or gummy spiders! Anyway, I am gaining a lot of weight. I had heard that it is not only me but other foreign exchange students as well who gain some weight. It must be something about American food that does it. I have noticed, however, that some of you girls at S.H.S. have really skinny legs. If you have a secret diet to survive on American food, please tell it to other exchange students.

I am glad to have the chance to stay here in Illinois and am proud to graduate from Southern High School.
