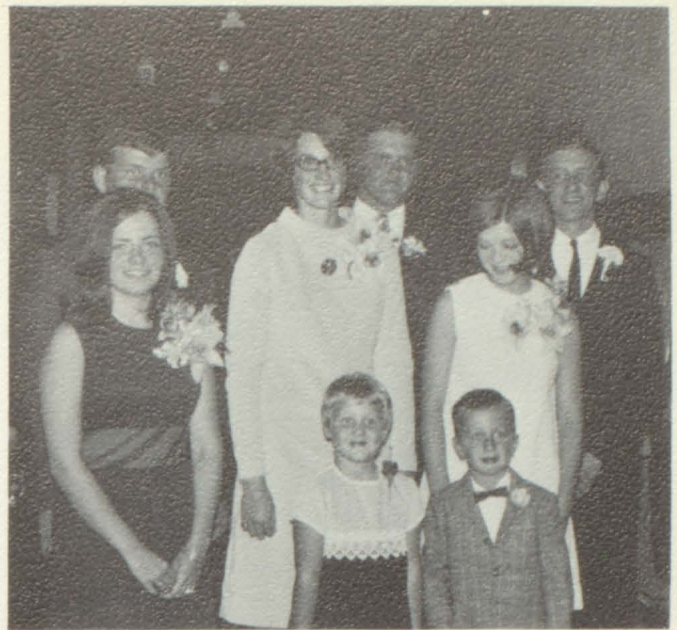


The annual Homecoming game started at 7:30 and ended at 9:30 with the Stronghurst Trojans defeating the Roseville Panthers 25 to 13.

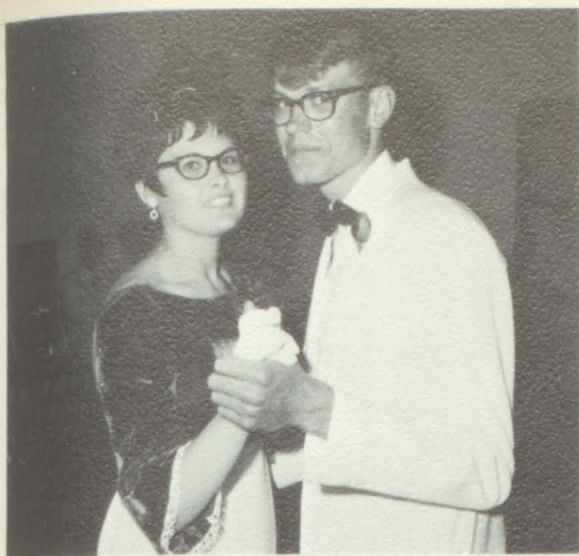


# *Junior-Senior Banquet and Prom* *1968*
