Stronghurst In Finals



BARTONVILLE, Ill.—Stronghurst Junior High's basketball team won its way into the finals of the state junior high tournament with a desperation sudden-death overtime win over Washington junior high of Chicago Heights, 60 to 59.

At the end of regular play, it was knotted 52-all. Chicago Heights had a 52-50 lead with one second remaining when

Stronghurst's Jerry Dillard fed Benny Dalton from out-of-bounds and Dalton pumped home a 30-foot shot as the buzzer sounded.

In the first 2-minute overtime, and three seconds to go, Dalton got the ball inside and was ringed by defenders but managed to feed Jeff Wilson who scored on a 6-foot jumper as the period ended, tying the score at 58-58.

Nearly Lost

In the sudden-death period, in which the first team to score two points, wins, Chicago Heights got the tip-off and took the ball down court. The player was fouled intentionally giving Chicago Heights two free throws. The player hit the first and Stronghurst called time out.

When play resumed, the player missed the second free throw and Stronghurst took the ball downcourt. Dillard fed Dalton under the basket

and he was fouled, sinking both free throws on a one-and-one situation with 58 seconds to go.

Dalton broke the tournament scoring record with 43 points, and also broke the Bartonville gymnasium high scoring record. He hit 17 field goals and 9 free throws. His excellent work at scoring was aided by Dillard's pin-point feeding, which drew praise from Coach Leroy Hammond.

104-Point Total

Dalton has scored 104 points in three tourney games, 36 in the first contest, 25 in the second and 43 last night.

Stronghurst will play Pekin Edison tonight at 7 o'clock for the junior high school championship of Illinois.

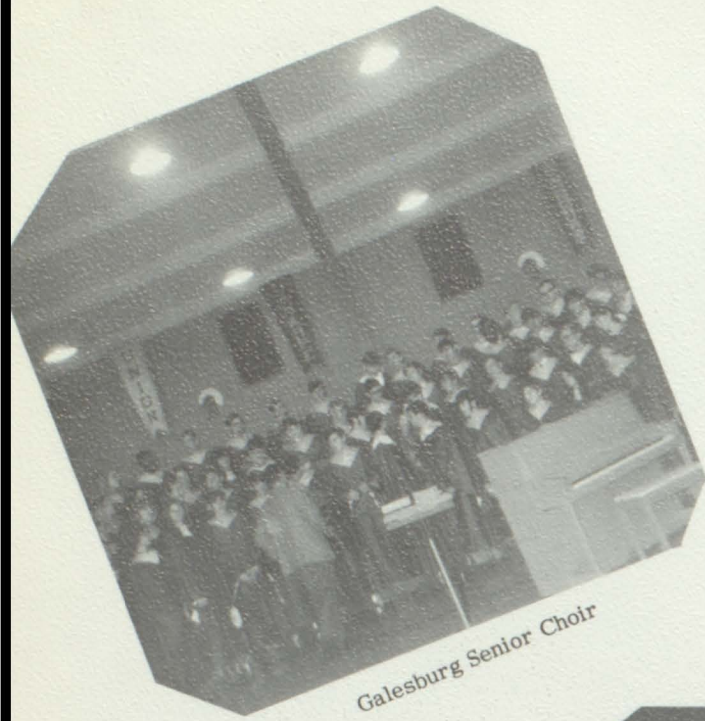
Due to the fact that our Christmas movie didn't come, we all suffered through the "exciting" adventures of "Jungle Cat."
