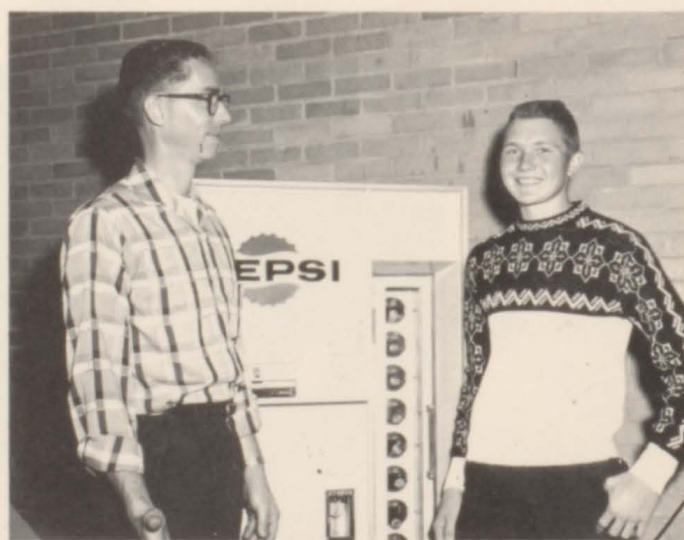




Important Meeting!
