## Union Track Squad Defeats W. Burlington



The Union track squad participated in eight dual and triangular meets this year to amass a total of $6101 / 2$ points, plus four large meets--the Bi-County, District, Roseville Relays, and the Fort Madison Relays.

As of May 15 three school records have been shattered as follows:

Steve Wegman placed second in the 880 yard run at the District meet to qualify for the State Meet in Champaign on May 22-23.

The squad topped the 100 mark in one meet this year, beating West Burlington $1061 / 2$ to $251 / 2$ and came close a second time with a score of $941 / 2$ to beating Dallas City (581/2) and Bowen (25). The other meets were more evenly matched and the scores lower.
