The Union High football team started out with high hopes. TACO JOHN'S 312 WASHINGTON ST. BURLINGTON, IOWA On May 27, 1975, the Union boys track squad was honored with a potluck meal in the Union High School cafeteria, along with the Union girls squad. The Union thinclads scored 638 1/2 varsity points during their '75 season in 14 meets, plus the W.I.U. Invitational and the State Meet in Charleston. The Fr/ Soph members had also participated in this division in the Bi-County. Overall the squad placed 2nd in the Keokuk Relays in Class C, 2nd in the Bi-County for the second year in a row, 4th in the Roseville Relays out of 14 schools, and 4th in the District Meet out of 23 schools, beating the closest Bi-County school by 13 points.



Carrying the bulk of the load for the Yankees were John Wegman and Rod Slover, both of whom earned varsity letters in track all four years at Union, and were members of the freshman squad that won this Bi-County division in 1972, and of the team that won the varsity Bi-County meet in 1973. During his four years, John Wegman earned a total of 311 1/2 points for Union, with 141 3/4 point earned during the '75 season. Rod Slover earned a total of 493 1/2 points for Union with 237 1/2 points being earned this year. Rod also became the all-time high score for Union, surpassing the previous record of 204 1/4 points set by Lyle Smith, another hurdler and long jump, in 1972.

In the records department, Rod Slover broke his own long jump record of 21' at the Yorkwood-Warren Relays with a leap of 22'2". At the same meet he broke the 330 yard low hurdle record of 42.3 seconds with a winning time of 41.2 seconds. The previous week at the Keokuk Relays, Rod set a new 180 yard low hurdle record of 22.1 seconds, and a new long jump record of 21'9". At the Bi-County Conference Meet, Rod bested his own triple jump record of 39'11" with one of 40'8". And his own 330 yard low hurdle record of 42.9 seconds with a 40.5 seconds.

In school records, Rod tied the 100 yard dash record of 10.2 seconds set by Lyle Jones in 1973, bettered his own triple jump record with one of 42'3 1/2", and better his 330 yard low hurdle record several times, finally ending with a 39.78 seconds set in the State Meet. John Wegman broke his brother Dave's mile run record of 4.47.3 with a 4:42.3 and, in a once-is-enough run at the Fort Madison Relays set a new 2-mile run record of 10:33.4 to replace the 1967 record of 10:34.6 set by Russ Jones when he won this event in the District Meet to advance to the State Meet. At the Roseville Relays the team of John Carner, Terry Coursey, Rod Slover, and John Wagman broke the Mile Medley Relay record set last year, with a winning time of 3:53.3 minutes.

On May 16, John Wegman won the high jump at the District Meet to advance to the State Meet, and Rod Slover won the long jump, the 330 yard low hurdles, and placed second in the triple jump to advance to the State Meet in all three events—a first in Union's history. The following week at Charleston, John and Rod participated in the Class A State Meet, where Rod placed 3rd in the long jump with a leap of 22' 1/2"—a nice finish to a high school career.

At the May 27 potluck, John Carner, Terry Coursey, Rod Slover, John Wegman, and Fernando Humphrey were awarded varsity letters. Other members receiving awards were Charles Bailey and Terry Meyer--back patches--and Sryan Tee and Bret Thyenumerals.
