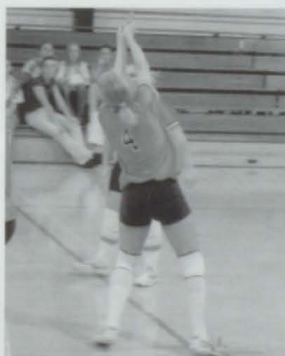

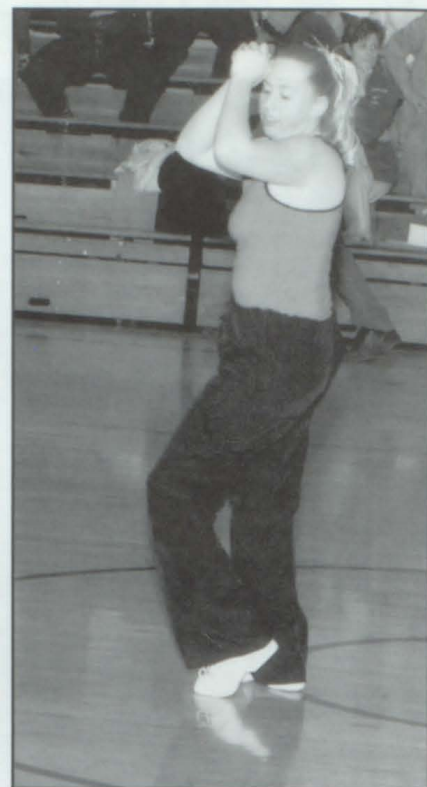
The Basketball Dance Team has had a very busy season. They have created and performed three original dances at many home Varsity boys basketball games and at one Varsity girls game.
