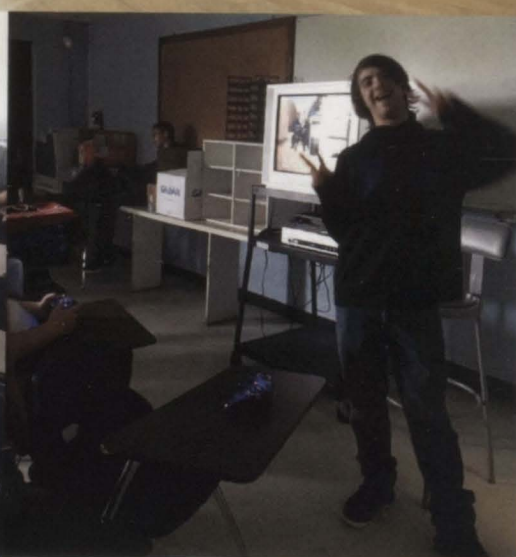
Class of 2016 Graduation
